ORDINANCE No. 2009-1

ADDING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS TO
PREVIOUS APPROPRIATIONS, AMENDING
ORDINANCE 2008-13 AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, revision of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance is necessary due to changing conditions which require adjustment in operations, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Ottawa Hills participated in an arbitration process related to construction of the stadium at Geresy Field, and as a result has agreed to pay Spring Valley Architects for services related to the project, and

WHEREAS, this payment reduces the original construction contract with Comte Construction, but requires a separate purchase order and appropriation, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTAWA HILLS, THAT:

SECTION 1. That there be appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund:

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meetings, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate protection of the public welfare, safety, health, and property, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
