

# VILLAGE OF OTTAWA HILLS, OHIO

## ORDINANCE No. 2009-3

ADDING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS TO PREVIOUS APPROPRIATIONS, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2008-13 and 2009-1 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, revision of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance is necessary due to changing conditions which require adjustment in operations, and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has applied for and been awarded a federal fire grant which covers 95% of the total cost of \$34,500 for fire equipment, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase the appropriation ordinance for the full cost of the equipment to be purchased, but estimated revenues will be also be increased by the amount of the grant, \$32,775, resulting in a net cost to the Village of \$1,725, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTAWA HILLS, THAT:

SECTION 1. That there be appropriated from the General Fund:

Fire Fighting, Prevention & Inspection	<u>ADDITIONS</u>
Capital	34,500
Total Fire Fighting, Prevention & Inspection	34,500

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meetings, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate protection of the public welfare, safety, health, and property, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.


