

# VILLAGE OF OTTAWA HILLS, OHIO

## RESOLUTION No. 2009-4

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR SALT FOR THE 2009/2010 WINTER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 5513.01(B) of the Ohio Revised Code provides the opportunity for a municipality to participate in contracts with the Ohio Department of Transportation for purchases of machinery, material, supplies and other articles, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Ottawa Hills wishes to participate with the Ohio Department of Transportation related to the purchase of salt and other ice and snow control materials for the winter of 2009/2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTAWA HILLS, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Village manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation on behalf of the Village of Ottawa Hills for the purchase of sodium chloride and other ice and snow removal materials and agrees to be bound by the following terms and conditions.

1. To purchase a minimum of 80% and a maximum of 120% of the estimated salt tonnage requirements indicated below, exclusively from the vendor awarded the sodium chloride contract for the county in which said political subdivision is located.
2. To be bound by the terms and conditions of the contract.
3. To be responsible for payment directly to the vendor for quantities purchased under the contract.
4. To hold the director of transportation and the Ohio Department of Transportation harmless for any claim or dispute arising out of participation in a contract pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B).

SECTION 2. The estimated salt tonnage shall be 800 tons. Salt is to be delivered to the Service Department of the Village of Ottawa Hills at 2125 Richards Rd., Toledo, Ohio 43606. The stockpile capacity at that location is estimated to be 130 tons.


SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in open meetings, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.



This legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency made necessary for the continued peace, health, safety and welfare of the community and for the further reason that the Department of Transportation will be seeking bids for salt in the immediate future. As an emergency it shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
