

VILLAGE OF OTTAWA HILLS, OHIO

RESOLUTION No. 2009-19

ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Lucas County, Ohio has certified its actions to this Council together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rates of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without, and what part is within the ten mill limitation for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing January 1, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTAWA HILLS, THAT:

SECTION 1. That the amounts and rates, as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification, be and the same are accepted by the Council of the Village of Ottawa Hills, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said Village the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation as follows:
