

VILLAGE OF OTTAWA HILLS, OHIO

ORDINANCE No. 2009-4

DECLARING CERTAIN ITEMS AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for methods to dispose of surplus personal property, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Ottawa Hills wishes to dispose of certain items deemed no longer needed for municipal purposes in a manner consistent with the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTAWA HILLS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The items identified in Exhibit "A" are hereby declared to be surplus and no longer needed for municipal purposes. Authorization is hereby provided to dispose of such items in a manner consistent with Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meetings, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate protection of the public welfare, safety, health, and property, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
