

# VILLAGE OF OTTAWA HILLS, OHIO

## RESOLUTION No. 2009-9

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH GEDDIS PAVING AND EXCAVATING OF TOLEDO, OHIO FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF ORCHARD ROAD BETWEEN INDIAN ROAD AND GALLATIN ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Ottawa Hills received eight bids on April 23, 2009 for reconstruction of Orchard Road, and

WHEREAS, The Village wishes to proceed with these improvements as soon as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OTTAWA HILLS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Authorization is hereby provided to enter into a contract with Geddis Paving and Excavating consistent with the plans and specifications developed by the Village and consistent with the bids submitted on April 23, 2009.

SECTION 2. Based on the engineer's estimate of quantities and the unit prices submitted by the contractor, the estimated total cost of the project will be \$526,126.77. Actual total cost for the project will be dependent upon quantity of materials removed and installed.


SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in open meetings, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 4. This legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency made necessary for the continued peace, health, safety and welfare of the community and for the further reason that the Village wishes to commence this construction project as soon as possible in order to assure its completion during the 2009 construction year. As an emergency it shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its passage.
